Thank you for picking up one of the Benefice Prayer Leaflets for our 2018 "Thy Kingdom Come" prayer walk. Prayer walking is as simple as it sounds - praying as you walk. When we prayer walk we are stepping into our authority as God's children to bless people and places in Jesus' name. This simple task is a great way to bring transformation to our local communities by asking God to break in.

This leaflet gives details of where we will be prayer-walking each day and the place we will meet. It offers a preparation and short verses of scripture from 'Thy Kingdom Come' daily prayer, which I suggest should be read reflectively before we begin the prayer-walk. The list of streets etc. given each day is given as a guideline and is not expected to be exhaustive and there are then some prayers to finish with.

However, I appreciate that not everyone will be able or want to walk with us, in which case please walk with us 'mentally', either linking up with others each day to pray or using the prayers alone. I hope that we will have a shared sense of praying together across our villages – a shared journey as we pray that "Thy Kingdom Come" in our communities.
